| Base Form | ING | Participle |
|-----------|---------|------------|
| growl | growing | growled |
| eat | eating | eaten |
| take | taking | taken |
| walk | walking | walked |

The Present: continuous and general truth: am are is, do, and does

I am taking my time.

Are you taking your time?

She isn't taking her time.

Do dogs growl?

Dogs growl (do growl).

People don't growl.

I disagree. People do growl.

These are my groceries.

This carrot is for the soup.

I am a pretty good cook.

Helping Verbs

1. Do, does, and did help the Base Form.
2. Am, are, is, was, and were help the ING.
3. Have, has, and had help the Participle.
4. Can, shall, will, could, would, should, may, might, and must help the Base Form.

The Past: continuous, specific and unspecific time: was, were, did, have, has, and had

She was eating sushi when I arrived.

I told (did tell) her not to stop on my account.

She had almost finished it by the time I got there.

Have you ever eaten sushi?

Sushi has always been a favorite of mine.

In fact, I ate (did eat) some last night.

That sushi was good.

The Future and Possibility: can, shall, will, could, would, should, may, might, and must

I will take the train.

I must take the train.

I can take the train.

I may take the train.

I might make the train.

Shall we take the train?

I should take the train.

I could take the train.

I would take the train if I had the money.
